The inspector.

A Document Inspector (shown)

General settings for whole project (e.g. looping, autostart, audio, etc.)

B Slide Inspector

Transitions between slides and individual slide appearance

C Build Inspector

Animations of individual objects (moving, scaling over time, fading in and out)

D Text Inspector

Text size, alignment, columns, outlines...

E Graphic Inspector

Visual settings for objects (shadows, reflections, fills, opacity, etc.)

F Metrics Inspector

Settings related to measurement (e.g. size, position, and rotation)

G Table Inspector

Insert and manage tables

H Chart Inspector

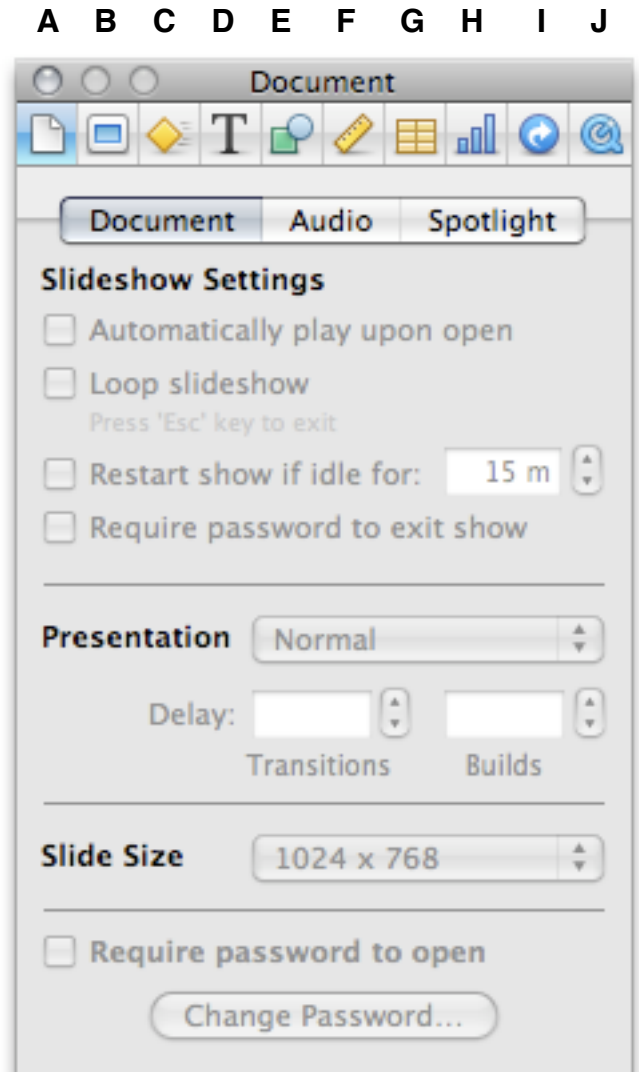
Insert and manage charts/graphs

I Link Inspector

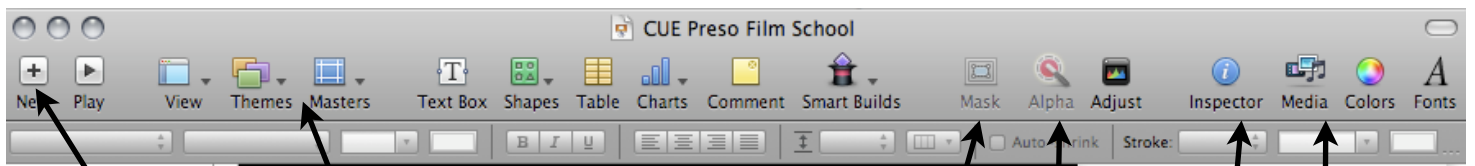
Manage hyperlinks and links to other pages in your keynote.

J Quicktime Inspector

Settings related to movies in your project.
